Volunteer Coordinator-act as an intermediary between various committee chairs

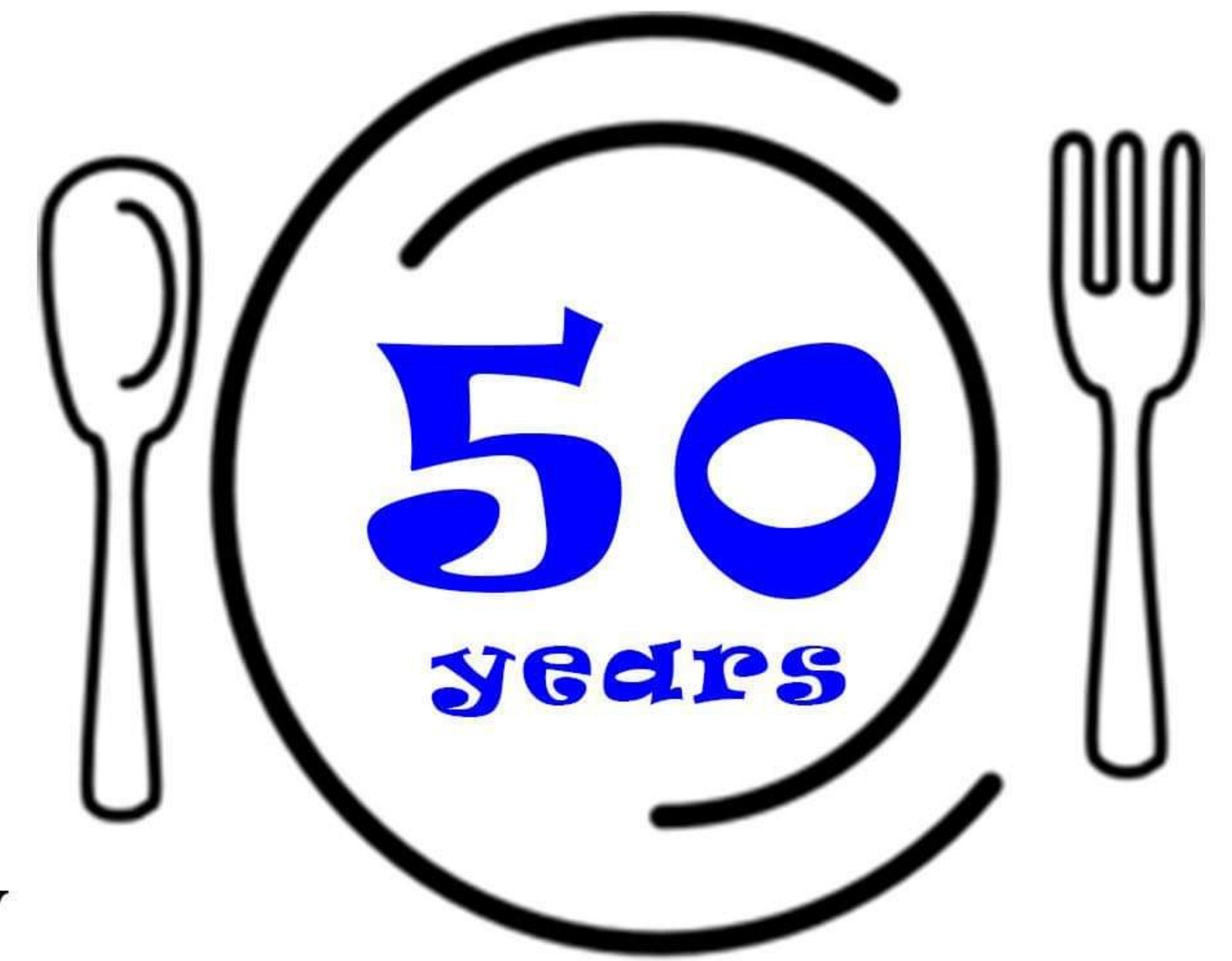
