Archives / Group Records (Phil @ 937-244-8223):

Darlene S. - I have called each of the 52 groups and followed up several times. Then updated the excel summary as requested. Some groups are continuing to follow up- will update both the excel and send Brian summaries as the remaining groups are in touch. Phil did a helpful summary for Brian to update the web info. I have yet to cross check the info, but will hopefully have a chance in a couple of weeks once this busy period is complete.

From the calls, 3 groups are no longer meeting: Adult Children Healing today in Dayton, Friday Downtown Brownbaggers in Dayton and Ada Adult Children Hope. Phil has gotten a preliminary update to Brian for the website and we have temporarily taken down the printed schedule due to so many changes being made.

Phil contacted Dennis K about converting the cassette tapes to digital media and Dennis said he would do that. Darlene and Barb located a storage unit company and we now have the Archives and Round-Up materials stored there. Pam asked about storing the Public Outreach materials and she will meet with Barb or Darlene to move the items there. Darlene, Barb and Phil have keys to the storage unit.

Institutions (Barb @ 937-430-5555): Nothing to report.

Public Outreach (Pam @ 937-681-0220): Nothing to report, however Public Outreach information and materials can be shipped out if needed – contact Pam.

Old Business: We have a storage locker. Barb, Phil and Darlene have keys and Nancy is processing payments. Pam will take the Public Outreach stuff there also.

Phil contacted the Church to let them know we will be meeting on Zoom through April, at least, and would not be making our donation payments during that time. The church also said they have yet to go back to full operations either. We'll keep them posted.

New Business: Pay pal donations can now be made on the web site now. Some groups sending their donations to the group treasurer, who is then sending them along. Brian will work on publicizing the Pay Pal donation feature on the web site a little better.

Rochelle, who attends the Wednesday Springboro Brown Baggers meeting was curious about what guidelines are in place regarding in person meetings. Most meeting locations are setting their own guidelines about masks and/or following state guidelines. With the pandemic at the level it is now, groups need to follow those guidelines if they choose to meet in person.

Nancy presented the budget 2021. Even though we wait to see what our income is before we budget it, we have the reserves to cover any shortfall next year. The budget is a bit “liberal” on some items, but Nancy stated it's easier to set the amounts now, and then revisit them if needed. Phil moved and Pam seconded to approve the budget. The motion passed.
