



Dayton Alateen Needs Your Support

We have three ways for you to help support Alateen:

1. *Do you know an adolescent or teenager who is trying to cope with an alcoholic parent, friend or other relative? **Bring them to Alateen...*** Alateen helps teens whose lives are affected by someone else's drinking by giving them the tools to cope. We meet every Tuesday at 7pm at Southminster Presbyterian Church, (Near intersection of I-675 and route 48) in the Ark Room. Pizza, cookies and water are provided!
2. *Are you looking for a rewarding service opportunity? **Become an Alateen sponsor!*** All you must do to be an Alateen sponsor is:
 - Be an Al-Anon member attending Al-Anon meetings for at least two years
 - Be at least 21 years old
 - Not have been convicted of a felony; not have been charged with child abuse or any other inappropriate sexual behavior; not have demonstrated emotional problems which could result in harm to Alateen members
 - Complete an FBI background check (it's easy and there's no cost to you)

Our team of sponsors works together to make sure at least two of us are at each meeting. Our teens run the meetings—we are only there as “chaperones”.

3. **Support Alateen with a personal donation** or ask your home Al-Anon Group to do so. The cost of providing food for meetings (about \$35 per meeting) is currently being covered by our Alateen sponsors.
